IV. Guest Speaker: Barb Kieffer, Insurance Policy

FVTC will soon be implementing a student accident insurance policy that will be carried by all students that attend FVTC. The insurance will cost \$7.50 per semester per student. This cost will be assessed for summer, fall, and spring terms. The cost of the insurance will automatically be included in the price of each student's tuition. This insurance covers students while at school or during school related events. The insurance does extend to club activities that are off campus. If a student is injured the benefit period for accident coverage is 52 weeks from the date of the accident. The insurance policy that will be provided to students is \$50,000 of coverage. This policy will be mandatory for every student and will cover 100% of all accident costs up to the \$50,000. Once the insurance program begins each student will receive an email from the insurance company providing more information on their individual coverage.
